# 15:50-17:50 Session 1: Mutual Learning among Civilizations and the Path to Coexistence among CICA Member States

Over the course of millennia, the cultural and civilizational evolution of CICA Member States has flowed like an expansive river, converging into the vibrant mosaic of contemporary Asia. The diverse cultural landscapes of Asia serve as the crystallized embodiment of humanity's knowledge and wisdom, constituting precious treasures for each CICA Member State. Instead of becoming sources of division or confrontation, the variances in culture and civilization ought to be harnessed as inexhaustible propellers of mutual enrichment and shared understanding. Consequently, this Session is dedicated to exploring the following focal points:

- 1) What underlying commonalities and pronounced distinctions characterize the civilizations across CICA countries? Which reservoirs of knowledge and experiential insights do you consider most invaluable for steering the developmental trajectory of present-day Asia and warrant dissemination to the wider community?
- 2) Amidst the prevailing international and regional dynamics, how can CICA Member States actively foster exchanges and mutual learning among civilizations, underpinned by the principles of reciprocal respect and understanding? To what extent has your nation's historical civilization played a pivotal role in shaping its contemporary national developmental trajectory, and has it gleaned insights and inspiration from the wellspring of wisdom embedded in other Asian civilizations?
  - 3) In light of the current international landscape, how can CICA

Member States channel their rich historical civilizations into fostering dialogue, understanding, and mutual learning? How can the diverse modes of modernization pursued by different nations be perceived in terms of historical and contemporary contexts, and what significance does the array of modernization models hold for the peaceful development of the region and the world?

4) As we progress towards constructing an intricate web of dialogue among Asian civilizations and intensify efforts to enhance mutual understanding, trust, solidarity, and cooperative ventures, how can the CICA mechanism assume a more robust role in driving these initiatives and further nurturing a climate of harmonious coexistence among its Member States?

# 14:30-16:00 Session 2: Security, Stability, and Win-Win Cooperation among CICA Member States

The intensification of international geopolitical conflicts has brought about a period of seismic shifts in the global arena. The ongoing march of globalization has encountered unprecedented challenges, juxtaposed with a surge in international and regional conflicts, marked by the COVID-19 pandemic's successive blows to the world economy, including the economies of the Asian region. This juncture urgently requires a recalibration of strategies. Moreover, humanity is currently grappling with the global climate crisis, an escalation in biodiversity loss risks, and the advent of fresh challenges ushered in by the rapid advancement of emerging digital

technologies. On a global scale, the imperatives of green and digital transformation loom large, exacerbating the urgency for sustainable development initiatives. Amidst this complex and stern international landscape, CICA Member States are mobilizing effective countermeasures to mitigate diverse security risks while advancing collaborative efforts that cultivate shared gains. To this end, this Session is focused on deliberating the following pivotal inquiries:

- 1) How ought the multitude of systemic risks and challenges confronting the world and the local region be interpreted? Which of these risks are analogous to "gray rhinos" and "black swans," demanding vigilant attention? How can the CICA mechanism be optimized to proactively address, prevent, and resolve security risks?
- 2) Against the backdrop of certain nations amplifying ideological schisms, advocating "decoupling" and risk aversion, and advocating for "friend-shoring" production and supply chain restructuring, what is the outlook for the development of open economic systems globally and regionally? How should we perceive the dynamic evolution of various multilateral, plurilateral, and minilateral mechanisms in the realm of economic development in the region? What strategies are required to bolster regional economic cooperation, promote open and inclusive development

networks, and ensure the openness and stability of essential raw material supply chains?

- 3) In the face of intensifying global climate change and escalating risks of biodiversity loss, what novel opportunities and challenges are unfolding for CICA Member States, particularly in the realm of green development and energy transition? What lessons and effective cooperation experiences in the realm of sustainable development, including collective response to environmental and public health risks, can be shared among the nations of the region? What novel challenges necessitate collaborative efforts?
- 4) How have the advancements in emerging digital technologies presented a realm of new opportunities for CICA Member States? Conversely, what novel security risks have emerged, requiring strategic responses? How can CICA Member States harness the wave of technological innovation to drive societal transformation, and to what extent can the CICA provide invaluable support in navigating these transformative waters?
