Sustainable Community Development

Applying Sufficiency Economy Philosophy from Theory to Practice

TICA: Thailand International Cooperation Agency is a national focal point for Thailand's international development cooperation. TICA was established in 2004 to realize Thailand's aspiration to be a contributor of development cooperation. Believing that global challenges are best addressed by international cooperation and global partnership, today we continue to strengthen our contribution to achieve global development agenda through various capacity-building and human resources development programmes. In response to the recent changes in the global landscape of development cooperation, especially through the concept of South-South and Triangular Cooperation, as well as Regional and Sub-regional Framework Cooperation, TICA continues to realign our focuses to match with constantly changing needs of our partners in the global community in order to deliver Thailand's commitment to be a relevant partner in global agendas including the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development as well as to support confidence building in Asia, especially through human resources development in needed fields.

Course Implementing Agency: Community Development Department, Ministry of Interior
Founded in 1962, the Community Development Department, Ministry of Interior is tasked to improve rural people's quality of lives by promoting participation and self-improvement. One of the Department's success projects is the introduction of the income generating programs such as the community saving group. It has proved to sustainably generate substantive income for community and enable them to conduct a number of their long-term development projects in response to their particular needs. Moreover, it is also one of the best practices in the application of Sufficiency Economy Philosophy (SEP) in tackling the country's challenges regarding development.

Target Countries:

Member States of the Conference on Interaction and Confidence Building Measures in Asia (CICA)

Theme: SEP

This training course falls under the theme – “Sufficiency Economy Philosophy” or SEP. Sufficiency Economy Philosophy is Thailand’s home-grown development approach addressing the importance of human development at all levels while ensuring the balanced way of life. SEP emphasizes the need to strengthen community’s resilience, with full respect to the environment. Applying SEP to their daily life, communities are to be well-immuned as they are self-reliant and, thus, are prompt to effectively respond to new coming challenges in order to reach all 17 SDGs. Therefore, over the recent years, Thailand has shared with international community including the CICA Member States, the application of SEP as a development tool with the vision to contribute to different aspects of global development.

For CICA Member States that share both similarities and differences in economic and social development policies as well as measures of handling the current global challenges, SEP is a practical approach of development that can take part in promoting peace, security and stability in Asia which is CICA’s priority task. With the application of SEP, Member Countries are to be equipped with immunity shields against ongoing and future challenges known as moderation, reasonableness and resilience, consequently gaining confidence in tackling difficulties and successfully building back together and better during pandemic situation and after.

Course Objectives

This training course aims at sharing Thailand’s experiences in applying Sufficiency Economy Philosophy (SEP) to its domestic development with CICA Member Countries in order to enhance sustainable development in the regional.

At the end of this course, participants are expected to;

- Acknowledge SEP as a practical approach of sustainable development and understand the concept as a community development mechanism guiding to self-reliance
- Apply the principle of SEP to their daily life in order to build their capacity in sustainable community development
- Engage SEP in the reflection of the shared experiences on the success and challenging factors in the process of strengthening community capacity among the CICA Member Countries

Course Contents:

The program consists of series of online lecture, practical session in vdo clip and project discussion.

- Community-Based Rural Development in Thailand Learning on promotion of community empowerment process
- Community-Driven Development: An approach of giving ownership of planning, decision-making and resource investment to communities
- Sufficiency Economy Philosophy: Theory and Practice
- Agricultural New Theory: Application of SEP in Practice
- Community-Based Microcredit
