CICA Seminar on Digital Forensics

Introduction

Sixth CICA Foreign Ministers Meeting (Nur-Sultan, October 12, 2021) approved an updated Catalogue of Confidence Building Measures, which includes a section "Security of and in the Use of ICTs". Russia is designated a coordinator, and China a co-coordinator of this direction for 2022-2023.

The Sixth CICA summit (Astana, October 12-13, 2022) at the initiative of Russia and China adopted the statement of the participating states leaders on security of and in the use of ICTs. Also approved were a concept document and a plan of implementation of the CICA trust measure on security in the sphere of ICT use and ICTs for 2022-2023, under which the first seminar on digital forensics is planned to be held in 2023.

Event Description.

Digital forensics involves applying scientific methods to information capturing systems for forensic purposes, identifying, collecting, examining and analyzing data while maintaining the integrity and continuity of the data chain located on computers or similar digital storage media.

Law enforcement agencies around the world are faced with the challenges of handling digital evidence in the absence of standard practices for its collection and analysis. This workshop will bring together and share best practices to effectively apply digital forensics to civil, criminal, and administrative investigations.

Date: August - September 2023 (to be specified).

Format of event: online.

Seminar organizers: Russia and _____.

Participants from CICA member states: representatives of interested ministries and agencies, experts in digital forensics of CICA Member States.

Objectives of the seminar: mutual exchange of experience and best practices in the field of digital forensics; strengthening the capacity of law enforcement agencies to improve the investigation and review of criminal cases involving digital evidence.

Possible issues for discussion:

1. Digital forensics: history of development and prospects.
2. National experience in collecting and analyzing digital evidence in criminal investigations.
3. international cooperation in digital forensics.
4. Data protection and privacy in digital forensics.
5. Training of specialists in the field of digital forensics.

Expected outcomes from the event:

The digital forensics discussion will enable workshop participants to gain a better understanding of approaches to respond to the challenges and issues facing the digital forensics community. Thematic papers and presentations by workshop participants can be used as background information.
