# CONCEPT PAPER BY TÜRKİYE ON THE PROPOSED ON-LINE MEETING <u>UNDER</u> <u>ECONOMIC DIMENSION – TRADE AND INVESTMENT</u>

Trade facilitation can basically be defined as the simplification and harmonization of international trade procedures which include practices and formalities involved in collecting, presenting, communicating and processing data required for the movement of goods in international trade. Trade facilitation can also cover the improvement of transport infrastructure, removal of government corruption, reduction of customs tariffs, resolution of non-tariff trade barriers, export marketing and export promotion. In brief, the main objective of trade facilitation is to improve the overall trade environment and reduce trade costs.

Therefore, trade facilitation is important in relation to cost and time-effectiveness connected to international trade. It also allows increase in trade and supports economic growth. In addition, it will strengthen compliance with trade regulations and minimize risks of errors and delays to supply chains.

Thanks to technological advances, information and goods have the potential to flow more easily than ever from one country to another. Trade facilitation measures help realize this potential by speeding up the movement of goods and the flow of trade information across the borders and throughout the whole supply chain.

WTO Trade Facilitation Agreement which entered into force on 22 February 2017, is a landmark achievement in setting the ground for a number of effective measures to reduce red tape and trade costs in trade and customs procedures.

One of the key issues for WTO Trade Facilitation Agreement, both during and after the negotiations of agreement, was the establishment of a body for coordinating implementation of measures contained in the Section I of the Agreement.

Article 23.2 of the WTO Trade Facilitation Agreement, which mandates the establishment and/or the maintenance of National Trade Facilitation Committees or designates an existing mechanism to facilitate both domestic coordination and implementation of the provisions of this Agreement, In this regard, due consideration ought to be given to international trade environment, border procedures and government structure in general in forming National Trade Facilitation Bodies. This situation makes it one of the both simpler and harder provision of TFA. Indeed, after five years of implementation, it is accepted that National Trade Facilitation Committees are organized differently in terms of their structure, members and mandate. Between these bodies, one of the criterion for success is broad and inclusive participation of the relevant in enhancing the work of these Committees.

It is in view of the foregoing that Türkiye proposes an on-line meeting among CICA Countries to better understand how individual National Trade Facilitation Committees function in CICA Countries, what the challenges are and which additional benefits can be drawn from individual country experiences.

**Expected Title:** National Trade Facilitation Committees Meeting Among CICA Countries: Challenges and Best Practices

<u>Purpose:</u> WTO's Trade Facilitation Agreement represents a milestone in creating binding and legal multilateral framework for wide-range of customs and trade procedures that are implemented to facilitate movement of goods across borders.

Article 23 under "Institutional Arrangements" of the Agreement foresees establishment and/or maintenance of a national committee on trade facilitation or designation of an existing mechanism to facilitate both domestic coordination and implementation of the provisions of the Agreement.

National Trade Facilitation Committees lie at the heart of the trade facilitation program of many countries, including many of CICA countries. Bringing together all stakeholders, both from government and private sector, National TF Committees allow comprehensive and effective implementation of the Agreement. In a way, it represents a nation-wide ownership of the whole TF Reform Process and Agenda in the countries involved.

Against this background, the purpose of the proposed on —line activity is to setting a platform for CICA Countries with National Trade Facilitation Committees -as well as those in the establishment of their National Trade Facilitation Committees-for an experience sharing as to the overall effectiveness and /or functioning of those bodies and identify, best practices in that regard.

Proposed on line meeting will also provide CICA Countries with an opportunity to share challenges faced, if any, in the overall functioning of their National Trade Facilitation Committees.

The event will spark new ideas by bringing together relevant participants from all CICA countries for ability to see what works well and what does not in these bodies. Also, it will present a forum for finding success points which is common in all well-functioning National Trade Facilitation Committees.

Lastly, event will present an environment for members of such Committees, customs and other regulatory agencies' officials, logistics professional to come together for exchange of ideas.
