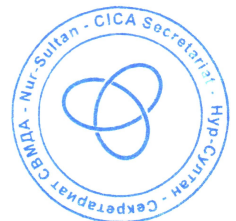

## **Information Exchange on Scanning Systems, Use of Technical Equipment and Projects**

### **Concept Paper**

#### **1. Background and Significance**

Volume of international trade is expanding. The social and technological transformation in the world is contributing to a faster transportation of goods and transfer of information while it is also increasing the competitiveness in the market. The new production techniques, which are derived from this technological transformation, forces us to undertake every transaction in an unprecedentedly faster pace.

In order to facilitate this new pace of trade and contribute to private sector's needs to be competitive and efficient in the market, customs administrations are working to be up to date in the context of infrastructure.

In this perspective it is apparent that customs administrations need to use as much technical equipment and automated systems as they can in an effective way. Increasing speed of trade is also making another aspect of international commerce more important which is security. Customs are modernising themselves to reach the effective security measures while trying to facilitate the rapid movement of goods.

Due to these factors our administration is doing its part and following the advancements in technical and administrative aspects in the world through both its own continuing applications and also projects which are realised in a defined period of time.

In order to combat smuggling in customs territory we are using a number of different technical equipment which serves in different areas. For example we are using non-intrusive inspection systems like x-ray scanners for having the visuals of inside of a trailer and also using CO2 measuring devices to detect if any living being is inside without exposing the vehicle to x-ray radiation. As another example to emphasise the diversity of controlled territory, we are using motorboats for maritime patrolling on the other hand we use CCTV cameras to monitor air and land border gates.

We are also benefiting from both national and international projects to increase our administrative capacity through different kinds of multilateral cooperations with various customs administrations and international organisations and also bilateral collaborations with individual countries to elevate our efficiency level of service for improving our both facilitation for trading of goods and fight against illicit traffic.

## **2. Objective**

Considering the reality of the speed of technological developments, experience and information exchange on use of tools is one of the key collaboration areas of CICA, the proposed online meeting will pursue the objectives listed below:

- Interactive exchange of information and experience between customs administrations of CICA members, which holds an utmost importance in this day and age of international trade.
- Sharing both technical and administrative knowledge on equipment use and projects for providing an extra insight to every party in order to improve their services.
- Creating a network among member state customs administrations for continual information sharing about developments on the proposed matters.
- Promoting exchange of experience on applied projects in order to discover best practices.

### **3. Organizational Matters**

Ministry of Trade (DG of Customs Enforcement) of the Republic of Turkey will present its practices. Participants from CICA members will share their practices and experience on the subject. Due to the spread of COVID-19, the meeting will be held online.

Contribution of relevant experts such as field officers and the specialists who hold the position of assessing the use of technical equipment and also running the administrative and applicative aspects of projects in general is expected.

**Concept Paper**

**1. Background and Significance**

The Detector dogs are used as one of the most important assistants of law enforcement institutions. In the areas where detector dogs are used, the workload of law enforcement officers decreases and contraband seizure rates increase. Detector dogs play a very important role in terms of seizure tons of narcotic substances, smuggled tea and tobacco products, weapons and explosives and cash.

Within this framework, Ministry of Trade (Directorate General of Customs Enforcement) of the Republic of Turkey has Dog Training Center which accredited by World Customs Organisation. In Dog Training Center mutual trainings could be done about Narcotics, Tea/Tobacco, Explosives, Public Order, Banknote searching dogs and their handlers.

**2. Objective**

The aim of the Online Basic Training Narcotic Detector Dog and Handler course program is to ensure mutual information sharing and increase level of narcotic drug seizures in the international arena by developing international cooperation.

**3. Organizational Matters**

Ministry of Trade (DG of Customs Enforcement) of the Republic of Turkey will present its practices. Participants from CICA Member States will receive training on Narcotics Detection Dog handling. Sharing of information and exchange of experience between participants are very welcome.
